CashTrans is pleased to report that the U.S. Senate unanimously gave approval yesterday to S. 3204, legislation that eliminates a regulatory provision - one that has become the source of frivolous lawsuits aimed at operators of ATMs. The bill <u>eliminates the requirements to post an</u> <u>exterior fee notice on ATM's in the U.S.</u> The bill will be sent to the President for his signature which is expected.

Many of the frivolous signage lawsuits will be eliminated by the removal of the physical signage requirement language in Reg E.
